- **Project Areas:** Hydroclimatology; Climate Variability Study; GIS and Remote Sensing Applications in Agriculture and Hydrology.
- **Required Skills:** Coding Skills and Basic Statistics
- **Eligibility:**
  - B-Tech in Civil Engineering/Agricultural Engineering/ Geo-informatics or allied areas with a GATE score (candidates with past GATE scores can also apply)  
OR
  - M.Tech in Water Resources Engineering/Geoinformatics or allied areas with a GATE score (Candidates with past GATE scores can also apply)  
OR
  - Master's in Science in Climate and Earth Sciences with CSIR-UGC NET (candidates with past CSIR-UGC NET scores can also apply).
  - PG Degree in Basic Science OR Graduate/Post Graduate Degree in Professional Course selected through a process described through any one of the following:
    - Scholars who are selected through the National Eligibility Tests, CSIR-UGC NET Including lectureship (Assistant Professorship) or GATE
    - The selection process through National level examinations conducted by Central Government Departments and their Agencies and institutions such as DST, DBT, DAE, DOS, DRDO, MHRD, ICAR, ICMR, IIT, IISc, IISER, etc.
- **Age:** Candidates who are not exceeding 31 years of age, as on the closing date of application, with relaxation to candidates belonging to OBC/ SC/ ST/ PWD categories and women applicants as per Government of India norms.
- **Appointment Duration:** 06 Months.
- **No. of Positions:** One
- **Salary Particulars:** The consolidated monthly remuneration for this position will be Rs. 25,000/- (Twenty-Five Thousand Rupees Only). Hostel accommodation may be provided at the institute based on availability on a chargeable basis.

- **Additional information:** The shortlisting of applicants for the written test/ interview will be based on their academic record and/or score in a qualifying national-level eligibility test (GATE/JEST/NET). CFTI graduates will be considered with a minimum CGPA of 8/10 (7.5 for OBC-NCL/EWS and 7.0 for SC/ST/PwD). Candidates will also have the opportunity to join a PhD program at IIT Palakkad.
